

Recycling in Norton County

All recyclables should be put in see through plastic bags (13gal.-30gal.)

What to Recycle

Plastics

Bottles & Jugs.....soft drink & beverage, cooking oil.....rinse thoroughly, remove lids
milk, juice, shampoo & detergent (these lids are not recyclable)

Glass

Clear, green & brown.....jelly, drinks, liquor, salad dressing.....rinse thoroughly, remove lids
food or beverage (no light bulbs, windows, mirrors,
bottles & jars (unbroken) or ceramic dishes)

Aluminum

Cans.....soft drink & beverage.....rinse thoroughly

Steel

Tin cans.....vegetable, soup, coffee, pet food,.....rinse thoroughly
empty aerosol cans, lids off jars make sure aerosols are empty

Paper

any type of paper or cardboard.....newspaper, magazines, catalogs,.....place in separate bag
paper (cereal/mix) boxes, office paper
cardboard (confidential papers should
be shredded)

Batteries

household, dry cell.....flashlight, watch, hearing aid, toys,.....place in any clear zip-lock bag or
calculator battery bags and take to Norton County
Landfill

Batteries

automotive, wet cell.....car, motorcycle, truck.....take to Norton County Landfill

Household Hazardous Waste

cleaners, insecticides, paint, pesticides,.....take to Norton County Landfill
stains, thinners, and poisons.
